


No alcoholic beverages, please. Not recommended for pregnant women.



Oar Rafts: Where the guide does all the work and you just enjoy the ride.

Paddle Rafts: Where all the participants paddle while instructed by a paddle captain. Suitable for ages 12 & older. To paddle 5 participants are needed.



"McKinley Run" Mildwater Class I. II. 8 Class I, II & one III 2 River Hours

A great trip for families & 1st time rafters! Hold on and enjoy the scenic section of the Nenana River by experiencing eleven exhilarating class II rapids, ending with one class III rapid. If you're lucky you may see Alaskan wildlife as you raft downstream 11 miles. Plan to be with us for 3 to 3.5 hours. (Suitable for ages 5 years & older.)

Check-in at: 7:30 & 6:30 (May 20-Aug 23) 12:30pm (May 20-Sept 10)

Oar or Paddle Raft: \$102.00/rafter ages 12 & up. Oar Raft only: \$77.00/rafter ages 5-11

(Small kids may be refused service)



"Canyon Run" Whitewater Class II, III & IV 2 River Hours

Hang on! It's whitewater ahead! You'll get wet and enjoy every minute of it as we head for Healy, 11 miles downriver. Get into real whitewater rafting as you hang on through rapids such as "Cable Car", Coffee Grinder", and "IceWorm." Plan to be with us for 3 hours. (Suitable for ages 12 & older.)

Check-in at: 7:30am & 3pm (May 20-Sept 10) 10am(June 5 -Sept 3) 6:30 pm(May 20-Aug 23) 5:30 pm(Aug 24-Sept 3)

Oar or Paddle Raft: \$102.00/rafter ages 12 & up.



Hour Scenic" Mildwater Class I, II & one III 4 River Hours

The four hour scenic is the perfect trip for families. It is just like the "Full Day", but without the whitewater. Experience beautiful scenery, enjoy a tasty picnic lunch, and keep your eyes out for wildlife as you journey 24 miles down the glacier-fed Nenana River. Reservations required. Plan to be with us for 7.5 hrs. (Suitable for ages 5 & older.)

Check-in at: 9:00 am (June 5-Aug 15) only offered on Monday and Wednesday

"Healy Express" Mildwater & Whitewater Class I, II, III & IV 4 River Hours

Get the whole enchilada on this combination of the "McKinley" and "Canyon Run". A brief break in the middle gives time for a quick snack if you wish to bring one. Plan to be with us for 5.5 hours. (Suitable for ages 12 & older.)

Check-in at: 7:30 am (June 5-Aug 23) 12:30pm (May 20-Sept 10)

Oar or Paddle Raft: \$153.00/rafter ages 12 & up (Recommended age for paddlers is 12 or older; requires 5 paddlers)

Mildwater & Whitewater

A quided scenic whitewater trip skirting the boundaries of Denali National Park down the glacier-fed Nenana River. This offers an excellent opportunity to experience wildlife in its natural environment and to travel the Great North Land as our early settlers traveled. Lunch served right on the river. Reservations required. Plan to be with us for 9.5 hours. (Suitable for ages 12 & older.)

Check-in at: 9:00 am (June 5-Aug15) only offered on Monday and Wednesday \$240.00/rafter ages 12 & up

Tour Descriptions:

Denali Raft Canyon Run: Hang on! It's whitewater ahead! You'll get wet and enjoy every minute of it as we head for Healy, 11 miles down river. Get into real whitewater rafting as you hang on through thrilling rapids such as "Cable Car," "Coffee Grinder," and "Ice Worm!" Your choice of Oar Rafts or Paddle Rafts (must have 5 participants to paddle). Approx. 3 hours from pick-up to drop-off.

Denali ATV Wilderness Adventure: Get ready for some adventure! Whether a novice or expert ATVer, this trip is a memorable experience in the Alaskan wilderness on your own automatic single ATV or multi-passenger Side-by-Side ATV! Riding along trails surrounded by Denali National Park, at speeds up to 30 mph, your adventure includes breathtaking 360° overlook stops with views of the Alaska Range, Otto Lake and the Healy Valley. Navigate through rocky creek beds and even spend time splashing through the water (weather dependent). Knowledgeable guides lead you through the rugged terrain & provide opportunities for photography. Wildlife is abundant - watch out for moose on the trail! Total tour covers about 10 miles with 1½ hours on the trails.
